Reading: We switched over to nonfic-
tion. During our mini-lessons, students are
learning how to pre-read, paraphrase in-
formation, find the main idea, and support
with details. Next week, we will look at
unknown vocabulary words and text struc-
ture.

Writing: We are writing informational writings! Everyone has a topic which he/she knows and cares about. Then we use our writing skills to write our inside paragraphs. We are learning how to develop our writing with descriptions, explanations, and examples. Next week we will add vocabulary words. Then learn how to write strong introductions and conclusions.

Science will be taught during the 2nd part of the year.

Social Studies: We started learning about the history of Michigan. History is the study of the past. Historians learn about history by gathering sources. We learned that there are two types of sources: primary and secondary.
